The IFLA Interlending and Document Supply (ILDS) Conference is a **major international forum** dedicated to **Document Delivery and Resource Sharing within the global library and information community**. The most recent edition, the 18th IFLA ILDS Conference (2024), confirmed the continuing relevance of interlending and document supply in supporting access to knowledge worldwide.

The upcoming conference is organized by the four public universities of Rome — Sapienza University of Rome, University of Rome Tor Vergata, Roma Tre University, and Foro Italico University of Rome — in collaboration with the IFLA Document Delivery and Resource Sharing (DDRS) Standing Committee. 




RECTORATE BUILDING MAPS
